### Purpose of the Grant

  - Thrive intervention across the school.
  - ELSA intervention in KS2.
  - Individual Reading Year 3 & 4
  - Catch up Reading Year 5 & 6
  - COMIT interventions KS2
3. Utilise Iris Connect to reflect, adapt and celebrate excellent teaching and learning.
4. Whole school wellbeing survey
5. Attitudes to learning survey
6. Monitor and support attendance across the school.
