Aneurin Bevan



- Born in 1897 in Tredegar, South Wales.
- He was the son of a coal miner.
- He saw poverty, illness and injustice in Tredegar and this shaped his ideas.
- He left school at 13 and became a miner.
- He became a Member of Parliament (MP) for Ebbw Vale in 1929.
- He believed healthcare should be free for everyone.
- After WW2 he became Minister of Health.
- The NHS officially started on the 5th July 1948, meaning everyone in Britain could see a doctor without paying.
- It was funded through taxes.
- In 1948 there were 1700 hospitals in the NHS
- Many doctors didn't want the NHS at the start.
- He is remembered as the 'father of the NHS.'
- The NHS is still one of Britain's most important organisations and helps millions of people.
- Today, the NHS is one of the largest employers in the world
- Aneurin Bevan died in 1960



Sir Tim Berners-Lee



- Born in London in 1955
- In 1989, he invented the **World Wide Web**
- He made it possible for people to share information and connect through websites.
- He did not invent the internet, this already existed, he invented the way we use it.
- 1991: the first ever website was published. It explained what the World Wide Web was.
- He made the web open to everyone.
- 2004: He became Sir Tim Berners-Lee.
- Thanks to him we can shop online, watch videos, play games and get information instantly.

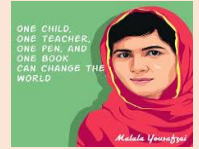

Malala Yousafzai



- Born in Pakistan on July 12th, 1997
- She is a Muslim.
- She went to a school run by her father, but many girls in Pakistan do not go to school.
- Believes girls have a right to education.
- In 2012, when she was 15, she was shot for speaking out about her beliefs.
- She started a charity called the Malala Fund to help give girls around the world access to education.
- In 2014 she became the youngest winner of the Nobel Peace Prize.
- She wrote a book called 'I am Malala' about her life and fight for education.
- The United Nations declared July 12th, Malala Day to recognise the importance of Education for all children.
- She once said, "When the whole world is silent, even one voice becomes powerful."
